

Vermont Chapter report for 2018

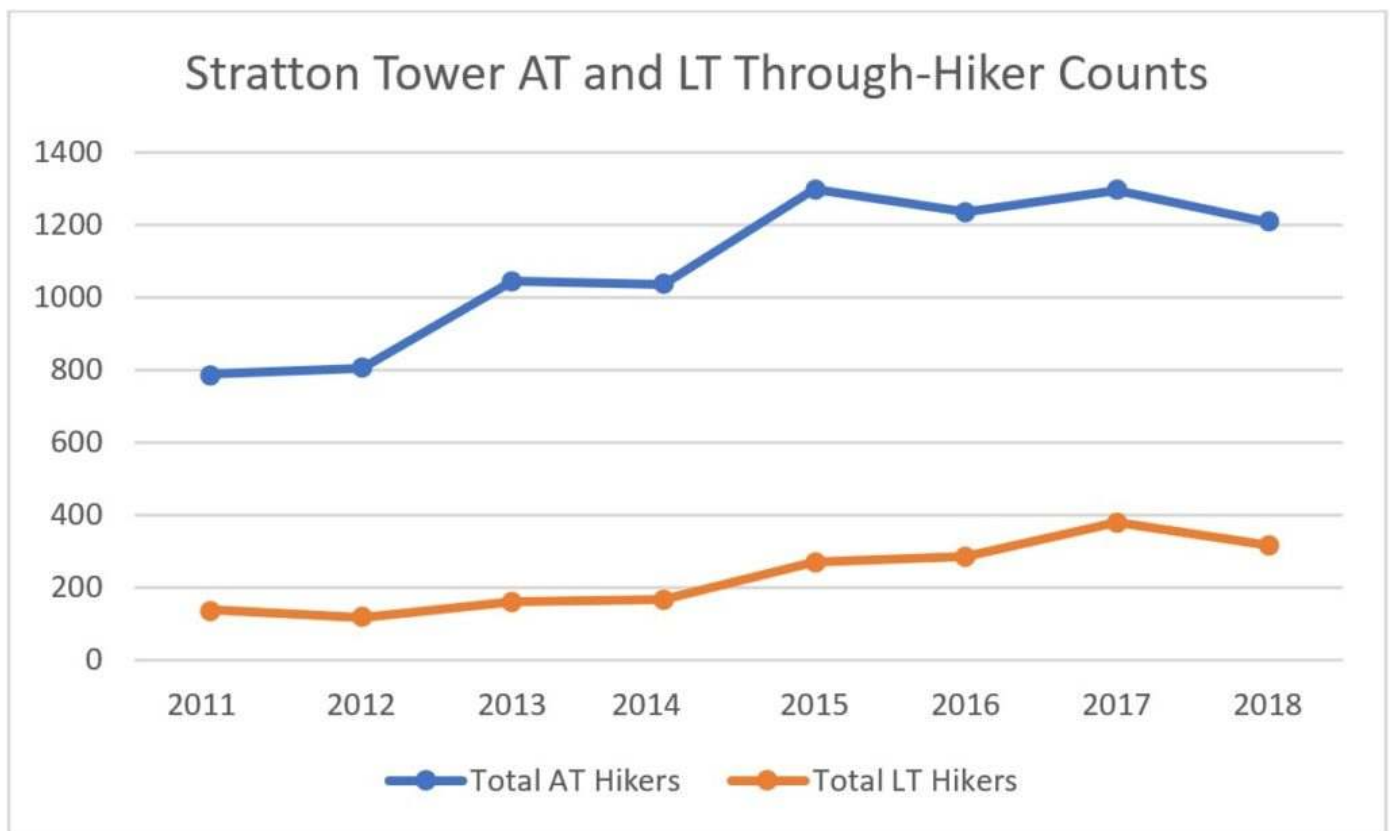
