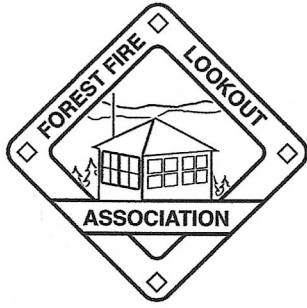




MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between the National Museum of Forest Service History
and the Forest Fire Lookout Association

Parties: The Forest Fire Lookout Association [FFLA], is a Pennsylvania nonprofit corporation that is dedicated to preserving lookouts and their collective legacy. The National Museum of Forest Service History is a Montana nonprofit organization dedicated to collecting, preserving, and interpreting the history of the Forest Service and America's conservation legacy for the education and enjoyment of the general public, scholars, and historical researchers.

Purpose: This agreement memorializes mutual cooperation, consultation, promotion and support between these organizations.

Terms of Agreement: The parties execute this memorandum to declare their mutual support as organizations and agree to consult, one with the other, on matters appropriate to that organization's mission. Each party will, when pertinent or topical, reference the other when communicating with its members, supporters and the general public.

Effective Date and Cancellation: This memorandum of understanding goes into effect when the last party has signed it, and remains in effect until canceled by either party.

Limitation: No financial relationship exists between the parties or is created by this memorandum of understanding.
